Project Objectives:

1. To serve the needy fulfilling the purpose of Lions using diverse strengths of lions clubs in Regions 1A and 1B.
2. To provide an opportunity for all Lions Clubs in Regions 1A and 1B to participate in several multi-service projects.
3. To serve the communities covering all 8 themes of lions international and the themes of Lions District 306C1.
4. To strengthen the mutual trust and collaboration among lions.

Multi-Service Project Background:

With the current lionistic year nearing completion setting the deadline to report all service projects by the end April, 2025, the leaders of the Regions 1A and 1B together with the respective Presidents identified the need to facilitate a multi-service project providing yet another opportunity for the clubs in the two regions to fulfil their service objectives. This decision was taken at an online meeting of the Region Officers and Presidents on 20th March 2025. It was identified that the best practical way to provide this opportunity is to organize a multi-service project covering all International and District themes in a close proximity in Colombo considering the involved

preparatory work if a remote area is selected. Having obtained the views of the Region Leaders, Siri Jinarathanaramaya Temple in Udahamulla was selected as a suitable venue for this multi-service project. Discussions were held between the temple authorities and the two Region Chairmen on 24th March and several projects were identified. These projects were further discussed among the Region Chairmen and the Presidents at a physical meeting held on 31st March, 2025 at the Lions Activity Center, Kotte and the responsibilities of the clubs and the contributions were identified. These details are given in the following sections.
