Project Description

Education is a fundamental human right and a powerful driver of personal and societal development. It equips individuals with knowledge and skills, fostering economic growth, reducing poverty, and improving health outcomes. Moreover, education promotes social cohesion, stability, and peace by instilling awareness of social and cultural norms, and encouraging civic participation. It empowers individuals to contribute meaningfully to society, enhances personal well-being, and is essential for addressing global challenges.

We, as Lions of Gothatuwa DLeoz selected a school in the rural area just like last year, in the central province. Thalawa Tirappane Vidyalaya is an under privileged school consisting of children and teachers about 130. The school location is in a very rural area where the village affected by Wild Elephants damages and was even not easy to access. There is only 1 government bus working in that area. The villagers make a living doing cultivation and hired work. They have strong determination to provide education to their kids, but face a lot of challenges in providing necessary requirements for the studies. For example, with the current inflation in the country, buying stationary items, uniforms, shoes and etc. is not easy for the parents.

We identified some of their needs and decided to do our **annual continues - multi service project** to provide service for the need. As Lions, we are happy, proud and overwhelmed by this project.

Phase 1 (Educational Support for Children) -:

On the day of the project 18 Jan 2025, we donated school books for the 120 students of the school. We hope that this donation would be very helpful for the students in the new school term. The excess school books were handed over to the principal so that they will be distributed among the other students later.

Phase 2 (Any Other Youth Development Related) -:

On the day of the project 18 Jan 2025, we donated musical instruments for the school band. We noticed that the Principal of the school, as a visionary leader has tried so much to bring the standard of the students to a greater point. They had a small school band, which had few instruments and most of the items were hand made using Throwaways. So we donated few musical items for them.

Phase 3 (School Diabetes Education) -:

On the day of the project, we did a diabetes screening project for the Students, Teachers and Parents. At the time the comments from all villagers were very good. For such a small test, they said they had to go to the main town and they appraised us for doing this in their village school.

Phase 4 (Planting 50,000 coconut plants Nationwide) -:

We donated 20 coconut trees to the school and at the same time the principal insisted the first Tree to be planted by the Lions of Gothatuwa DLeoz. So on his kind request, we planted the first Coconut tree at the school premises.

Phase 5 (Educating parents of School children about Child Cancer, symptoms and how to cure) -:

Globally, approximately 100,000 children lose their lives to cancer each year. Children in low and middle-income countries are four times more likely to die from cancer than those in high-income countries, primarily due to limited access to effective treatments. So we at Gothatuwa DLeoz with the direct supervision of the project chairman carried a Child Cancer awareness programme on the same day of the Pipena Kekulu Project on 18 Jan 2025.

Phase 6 (Lions Image Building) -:

On the day of the donation on 18 Jan 2025, we provided the Principal and the Teachers with small token of appreciation for the Superb service they do at the School. We as DLeoz had a discussion about this and agreed to gift all the staff with a Mug imprinted of Lions Logo and Club Logo. We expect that this would help in building the Lions Image in the future.

Phase 7 (Nutritional Meal Programs & Education Workshop for School Children)-:

On the day of the books donation project Pipena Kekulu, we provided the Students, Teachers and the parents with a small refreshment. It was a hot day and even the kids loved a chill ice-cream. They all loved it.

Phase 8 (Any other disaster relief related project)-:

On the day of the Books donation on 18 Jan 2025 at the Thalawa Thirappane Vidyalaya, the School Principal pointed out that the fence of the school is half finished and work has been concluded due to lack of funds. He pointed out that the village often affected by wild elephants damages and he is really concerned about it. Safety of the children and the other staff was very important. The Project chairman Lion Kanchuka decided at the same point that we should help them out since it's a very vital issue. So we donated Rs. 25,000/- to the school to continue building the fence around the school.


